Questions to Ask a Contractor

- How long have you been in business?
- Can you provide references from recent projects?
- Do you have insurance and necessary licenses?
- What is your estimated timeline for this project?
- How do you handle changes or unexpected issues?
- What is the payment schedule?

- Detailed scope of work
- Timeline and project milestones
- Payment schedule and terms
- Warranty and guarantees on workmanship
- Process for handling disputes or changes

Steps to Finding the Right Contractor



Stay involved with regular check-ins to ensure work aligns with expectations.

Ask for References and Contact Them

Speak to previous clients about their experiences and satisfaction with the contractor's work.

Verify Licensing and Insurance

Ensure the contractor is fully licensed and insured to comply with local building codes and protect against liabilities.

Request Multiple Quotes

Get at least three quotes to compare pricing, scope, and timelines. Be cautious of unusually low bids.

Don't rush into hiring the first contractor who seems reasonable. Take the time to research, compare options, and verify credentials to ensure you're making the best choice for your project.
